“J-Rise” Relevant Implementation Strategies to Eliminate the social and structural barriers associated with the HIV community. Services extended to Black men who have sex with men, that seek Justice. This is a five (5) year study.

## Priority Populations



Priority populations include: Black MSM, Black transgender and gender diverse individuals, and Black heterosexual women living with and vulnerable to HIV who are currently incarcerated, on probation/parole, and have a recent history of incarceration

## Interventions



Interventions related to this study may include transitional case management, employment navigation, contingency management, and employer outreach support with high fidelity for enrolled participants.

## How to determine eligibility?

## Incentives



Participants who meet eligibility criteria and are enrolled may receive incentives, such as a \$50 baseline survey, \$50 for a 6-month follow-up, \$50 for a 12-month follow-up, and \$60 for completing a locator form. Additionally, individuals randomized to the employment navigation intervention may receive up to \$200 for employment-related supports, while those in the contingency management intervention may receive up to \$140.
